

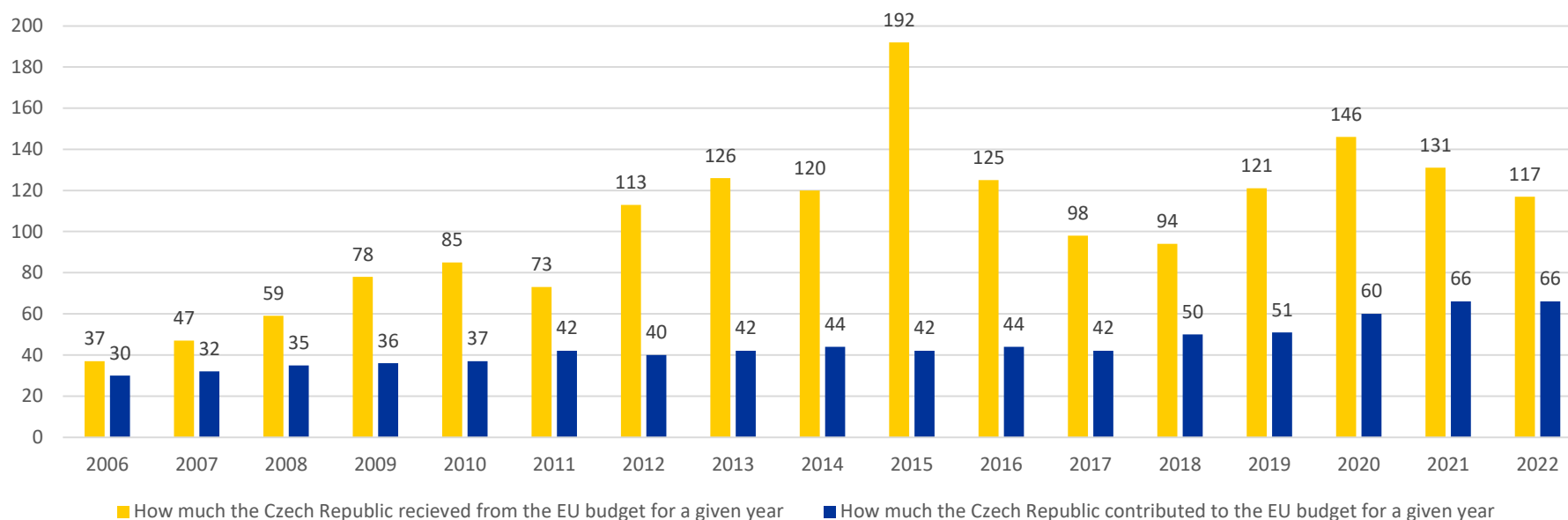
Did you know that the Czech Republic has gained much more financial resources from the EU than it has paid towards the common EU budget?

Yes indeed! While since its entry into the European Union in 2004 the Czech Republic has contributed to the EU budget by over 33 bln. EUR, it has since then gained as much as nearly 76 bln. EUR. The 43 bln. EUR surplus has helped to co-finance tens of thousands of projects, thereby significantly improving the quality of life in the Czech Republic.
